

Caring Communities focuses on Care Management, a whole-person approach to helping those living with HIV and other sexually transmitted infections. Our system offers comprehensive care for a complex disease.

CASE MANAGEMENT

Case management services are available to those living with HIV within our 12-county service area.

Our case managers help clients living with HIV access medical services and better manage their health through referrals, transportation to appointments, and medication adherence support. Additionally, we offer services such as housing assistance and support groups.

PHARMACY SERVICES

This program allows eligible individuals enrolled in services through our clinics or HIV case management to have 24/7 access to a pharmacist for any questions or needs they may have. With this program, client's medications are mailed either directly to their home or our offices, whichever may be more convenient.

PREP SERVICES

PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) is a pill taken once a day that can help prevent those at risk from getting HIV, even if they are exposed to the virus.

PrEP reduces the chances of contracting HIV by about vhen taken as prescribed

Our PrEP Navigator works with anyone interested in starting PrEP to screen them for risk, educate them about PrEP, and follow-up with them throughout treatment.

CONDOM DISTRIBUTION

Caring Communities partners with various venues in our area to distribute free condoms to their clients and customers who are at a higher risk for STI/STDs and/or HIV.

SEXUAL & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH CLINIC

Our clinics offer free and low-cost services to those concerned about sexually transmitted infections/ diseases (STI/STDs) and other reproductive health concerns.



Testing

Testing for gonorrhea, chlamydia, syphilis, bacterial vaginosis, trichomoniasis, herpes, HIV, hepatitis C (HCV), and additional STI/STDs

Treatment

Treatment for gonorrhea, chlamydia, syphilis, bacterial vaginosis, and trichomoniasis

HIV Care Anti-retroviral treatment and laboratory services for case-managed clients

Prevention

Full PrEP services and free condoms (including non-latex)



Information

Accurate, non-judgmental answers to questions about your sexual health, risk reduction planning, and information and referrals to additional community resources

Reproductive Health

Routine gynecological care including pap smears, pelvic exams, breast exams, contraceptive services (including oral, injectables, patches, and rings), basic infertility services, and pregnancy testing and counseling

Our clinics also offer limited in-the-field testing opportunities at venues that cater to at-risk populations. Common venues include LGBTQ bars and campgrounds, colleges and universities, and outpatient drug/alcohol treatment facilities.
